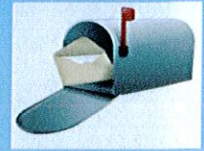

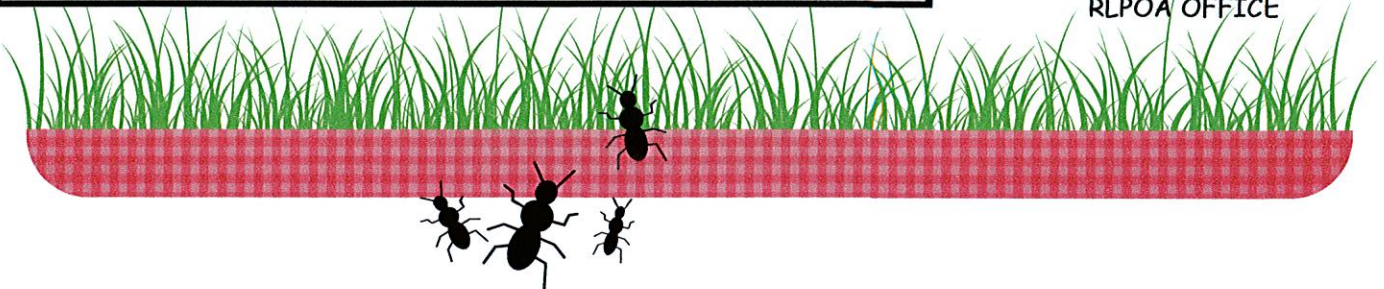

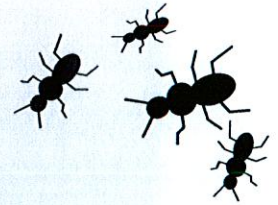

General Housekeeping and Maintenance in Reflection Lakes.....
