- 3. BE RESPECTFUL OF YOUR NEIGHBORS AND COMMUNITY QUIET TIME IS FROM 11PM UNTIL 8AM

KNOW YOUR PROPERTY BOUNDRY LINES, DO NOT TRESSPASS ON OTHER'S PROPERTIES. USE THE COMMON AREAS THAT IS WHY WE HAVE THEM

CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF AND DO NOT LITTER




