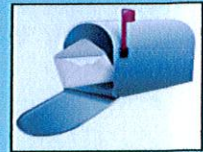

General Housekeeping and Maintenance in Reflection Lakes.....

RLPOA RULES & REGULATIONS REMINDERS.....

1. ALL ATV, UTV, GOLF CARTS MUST HAVE AN RLPOA PLATE WITH THE 2017 STICKER ON THEM.
2. THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO JOY RIDING ON THE ROADS WITHIN THE GATES. USE THE TRAILS AND IF YOU HAVE A CHILD WHO IS LEARNING THERE ARE SPECIFIC AREAS FOR THEM TO PRACTICE.
3. BE RESPECTFUL OF YOUR NEIGHBORS AND COMMUNITY
QUIET TIME IS FROM 11PM UNTIL 8AM
KNOW YOUR PROPERTY BOUNDRY LINES, DO NOT TRESSPASS ON OTHER'S PROPERTIES. USE THE COMMON AREAS THAT IS WHY WE HAVE THEM
CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF AND DO NOT LITTER
PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THIS IS A FAMILY ENVIRONMENT
4. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 10 MPH, THIS MAY BE FRUSTRATING AT TIMES TO ADHERE TO BUT IT KEEPS US ALL SAFE AND THE DUST DOWN.
5. YOU MUST WEAR A HELMET ON ATV/DIRTBIKES
6. THE GARBAGE COMPACTOR BY COMFORT STATION #4 IS FOR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE ONLY (THIS MEANS KITCHEN GARBAGE LIKE FOOD, ETC. MICROWAVES ARE NOT HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE)

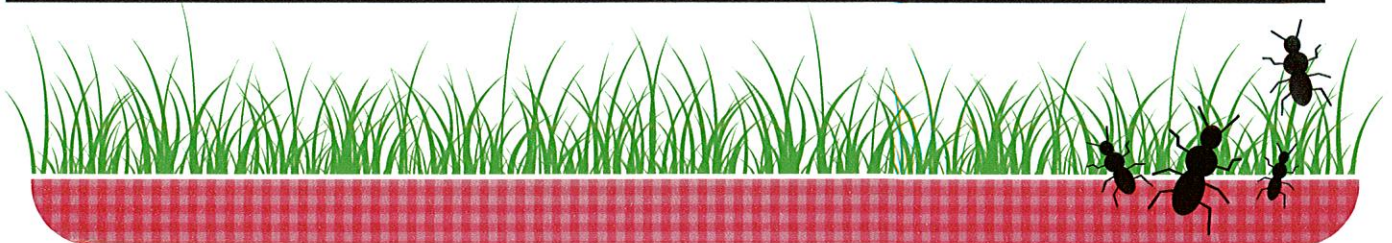

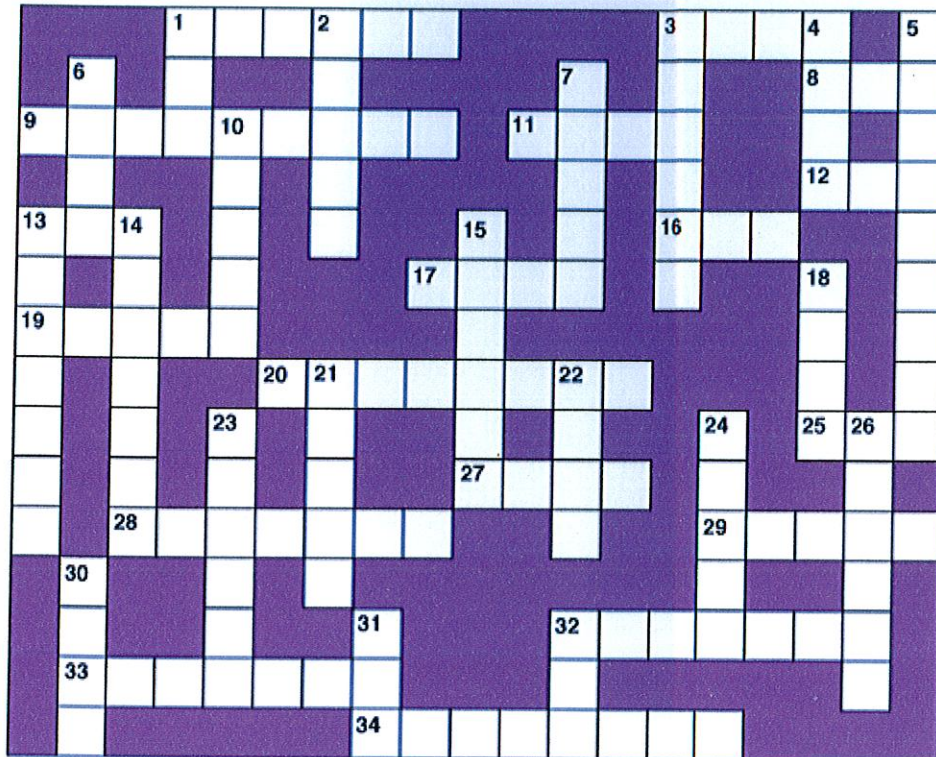
